Florida Junior Classical League State Forum Rules for Creative Contest: Digital Art

IN ADDITION TO THE SPECIFIC RULES LISTED FOR THIS CONTEST, THE PROJECT MUST ALSO ADHERE TO THE RULES LISTED IN THE GENERAL RULES DOCUMENT.

- 1. Projects must have been developed on a digital medium and printed out to be submitted at State Forum. Projects must be printed out on photographic weight paper.
- 2. This category includes such projects as digital or film photography and other graphic art developed using software (e.g. Photoshop, Lightroom, Adobe Draw, Procreate, Canva, etc.).
- 3. All art included in the project must be the original work of the student. Material from any source other than your own digital photographs (if applicable) may not be used.
- 4. Project surface must be between 8 x 10 inches and 16 x 20 inches. Entire submission (including mat and/or frame) must not exceed 20 x 24 inches.
- 5. A project may be framed, but no project may be covered with glass, plastic, or lamination.
- 6. Only one print may be submitted as a project. Smaller prints may not be grouped together.
- 7. A completed description card must accompany the project entry. Participants must list the name of the software package used to create the image and describe the enhancement process —including any significant filters or processes used— on the 3x5 card.
- 8. A one-page typed explanation of the making of the project **IS REQUIRED** to accompany the submission. Photos of different stages of the project are highly encouraged. Proper credit in a standard bibliographic format must be given. No text may be plagiarized, or project will be disqualified.
