

Attached, you will find the documents and links necessary to register for the 2019 State Latin Forum, which will take place at the Orlando Wyndham Resort April 4-6th. This is a rather lengthy message with a lot of information; please read it thoroughly, as there are a number of special notes and changes for this year. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at kyoungblood@maclay.org. Please note the deadlines. Registration materials must be e-mailed by **March 4**. The registration check must be mailed with a postmark date no later than March 4. Late registrations may be submitted with a \$50 late fee until March 11. The hotel must RECEIVE your first night's payment by **March 4**, and your balance must be paid by the date of your arrival.

2019 State Packet 1 Rules and Registration Information: This document contains the rules and registration information for State Forum, including **deadlines** and mailing addresses. Please read this document carefully, particularly the information which has been added about non-competitive, additional delegates. **If you have a question, check here first! ☺**

2019 State Packet 2 Delegate Registration Forms and Discipline

Forms: This document requires you to use Microsoft Word. It is a protected document, which means that you can only make changes in the specified form fields. Because this is a protected document, you will NOT be able to use your mouse to select any text which is not part of a form field (the highlighted areas). The easiest way to navigate through the document is to use the TAB key. You must completely fill out the registration forms in order to compete at State.

After you have entered the necessary information, print the document. This will ensure that all the fields auto-populate. Finally, use the save as command to rename the document with your school's name. E-mail the electronic version to me no later than the deadline of **March 4**.

Special note about contests: Each student may compete in only two contests (not counting Certamen and Ludi/Olympika). This means that each student may register for two academic tests, an academic test and a costume/oral, or an academic test and a project. If a student enters more than two contests, ONLY the two listed on his/her official registration will count; the

other contest(s) will be disqualified. The Registration Form only allows you to enter two contest numbers for this reason! [The only exception to the two contest rule is a student taking the Academic Decathlon or the Greek Language tests, because these tests do not count for Sweepstakes points.] These rules may not be the same as your Regional rules, so if you have any questions, please contact me kyoungblood@maclay.org.

2019 State Packet 3 Hotel Registration Form: This document contains the necessary information for reserving your rooms at the hotel. Please pay careful attention to the hotel's deadline of **March 4**. If you have any trouble with the deadline, please contact the hotel. Make sure to follow up with the hotel prior to State in order to ensure that reservations and payment have been received.

2019 State Packet 4 Additional Delegate Registration for registering your Additional Delegates Refer to page 2 of the Rules and Registration Information document for an explanation of the Additional Delegates. These registrations should be submitted via email to the registrar by the deadline of **March 4**.

This will be used to register the following information: Sponsor Information, Chaperone Information, Certamen, and Ludi (including Open Certamen and Agon). Please click on the link and progress through the form. Further instructions appear on the form itself. We have found that this has helped to make registration easier and more streamlined for all involved.

Special note for Regional Certamen Winners: Although the winners of each Region's Certamen tournament automatically qualify to play at State, it is still necessary for the winners to submit a Certamen Registration through the online form, so that the Certamen Chair knows how many teams intend to compete.

The following information will be posted on the FJCL website (FJCL.org):

2019 State Academics and Sweepstakes Information detailed information about level of Latin AND student eligibility. This also lists the Academic contests offered at State and explains how points are awarded for Sweepstakes. Please read it carefully.

2019 State Orals and Costumes Information the rules for costumes, declamations, dramatic interpretations, and orations are found here. You will find links to the passages in the State Forum section of the FJCL.org website.

2019 State Projects Information: The rules for the various project categories, including pre-judged projects are listed here. Please note: At State, a Project counts as one of a student's competitive contests; s/he may not submit a project AND take two tests. If that happens, whichever contest is not listed on the school registration form will be disqualified.

Special note about Pre-Judged Contests: The deadline for the pre-judged contests is the same as the regular registration deadline. There will be no late registration for pre-judged projects and no late submission will be accepted. Additionally, electronic submissions must be accessible to the Project Chairs by the deadline (e.g. Google Docs shared).
