BOYS WILL BE BOYS

Olim Graeci milites cogebant. Mater Achillis filio dixit, "Si contra Troianos pugnabis, misera ero. Ad insulam Regis Lycomedis te mittam. Habita ibi inter puellas et gere stolam pallamque. A Graecis non invenieris."

Ulixes qui Achillem petebat ad hanc insulam venit. Non Achillem vidit, quod is erat similis puellae et Pyrrha appellatus erat. Ulixes multa dona portabat et filiabus regis et amicis earum ea monstravit. Inter omnia haec gladius erat: Puellae gemmis et reliquis pulchris delectabantur.

Subito Ulixes clamavit, "Ad arma, omnes!" Puellae a loco cucurrerunt, sed Achilles gladium cepit. Tum verba Ullxis audivit: "Te inveni, soci. Non puella, sed vir es. Miles esse debes. Mecum veni."

Quod sapiens erat, Ulixes ex omnibus Graecis Achillem invenire potuerat.
