## Florida Junior Classical League State Forum Rules for Creative Contest: Audio/Visual

IN ADDITION TO THE SPECIFIC RULES LISTED FOR THIS CONTEST, THE PROJECT MUST ALSO ADHERE TO THE RULES LISTED IN THE GENERAL RULES DOCUMENT.

- 1. This category will be prejudged.
- 2. Prejudged projects may ONLY be submitted electronically to the Google Form link in the State Registration documents by the prejudged registration deadline for State Latin Forum. Projects not received by the registration deadline will not be judged.
- 3. The project itself should be accessible from a link to an Internet-based storage or hosting site, e.g., Dropbox or YouTube.
- 4. If not using an internet-based host for viewing, submission files must be in a format (such as .mp4 or .mov) to be able to play on a PC using Media Player or need no additional software to play or download. After starting, the submission should be able to run on its own and should not require manipulation for the remainder of the presentation.
- 5. The maximum length for these presentations is 5 minutes.
- 6. The project can be a combination of information and entertainment. Quality, not quantity, will be more heavily scored by the judges.
- 7. Although other students may be involved in the production, the student submitting the project must have written, directed and edited the project.
- 8. Submission types may include short film/documentary, stop motion, animation, guided tours of computer programs or websites developed by the student, and slideshow presentations developed by the student.
