Rules for Creative Contest: Digital Scrapbook

A JCL chapter may submit either a traditional paper scrapbook or a digital scrapbook, but not both. If a JCL chapter submits a traditional and digital scrapbook, both will be disqualified. Scrapbooks of the same type/medium will be judged in two groups: Junior Division and Senior Division (as stated in the chapter's registration form).

The scrapbook should be a record of the chapter's JCL activities since the end of the previous school year's State Forum. The scrapbook should be entirely new. All materials in the scrapbook should pertain to Latin, the Classics, or Junior Classical League. Materials that are directly related to the club's activities may be included (e.g., maps, programs, etc.). Collaboration of multiple club members is permitted and encouraged in this event.

1. This category will be prejudged. Entries may be submitted two ways: (1) electronically through email or (2) on a physical storage medium, such as a DVD, CD, or USB flash drive.
2. Digital scrapbooks submitted electronically must be sent to the Project Co-Chair by the registration deadline for State Latin Forum. Projects not received by the registration deadline will not be judged.
3. Digital scrapbooks submitted electronically must have in the subject line of the email the following information in this order: category, school name, sponsor name, e.g., Digital Scrapbook Senior Division, Hogwarts High School, Professor Severus Snape.
4. A submitted disc or USB drive must only contain files necessary for the project; no other files should be present.
5. Points will be deducted if proper credit in a standard bibliographic format is not given for audio, video, picture, and text sources.
6. If a commercial program is used to create graphics or other special effects, credit must be given at the beginning of the scrapbook.
