ITINERARY

July 23 (very early in the morning) approximately 2:00 pm 2:00 – 7:00 pm approximately 10:00 pm	Pickups at various locations Buses will meet up in Atlanta Tour World of Coke Museum and Georgia Aquarium Arrive Hotel, Chattanooga, TN
July 24 (less early, but still early) 1:00 pm 3:00 pm 6:00 pm	Leave Chattanooga for Mammoth Cave, KY Arrive Mammoth Cave, do cave-related activities Leave Mammoth cave and head to Nationals! Arrive EKU!
July 30 (very early in the morning)	Come straight home, with stops for meals and bathroom as needed.

COST

The cost for each JCLer on our itinerary is going to be **\$300**. This covers the bus to and from Nationals, the overnight hotel room in Chattanooga (4 per room), entry to both the World of Coke Museum and the Georgia Aquarium, fees for the tour of Mammoth Cave, and the FJCL spirit fee.
